
Multiseeder Seeding Cylinder

The Kimseed Multiseeder is designed to maintain a mix and meter out all types of seeds and is especially suited to lightweight fluffy seeds. These seeds will not flow through conventional seeders.

The Multiseeder can also meter out semi-cleaned seed, which contains small sticks, stones and trash.

When operating, the Multiseeder rotates causing a rolling action on the seed inside. An agitator bar stirs the seed and forces it out through the two rows of hole openings (apertures) along the cylinder. Optimum speed is approx. 50-60 rpm.

Seed Box Option



Different types of seed as well as fertiliser may be mixing in the cylinder at the same time.

Even Trashy seed samples can still be metered out by the Multiseeder. A seed hole KEY with 5mm graduations is used to ensure all of the holes can be easily set at the same opening. If very small seeds are to be sown without fertiliser then the seed should be mixed with a carrier such as vermiculite No. 4 or dry sand to give a more even seeding rate.

Seed Box Can be added to the Imprinter to assist in the total operation. Ask Kimseed for more information on design and suitability of seed boxes that can be used.
